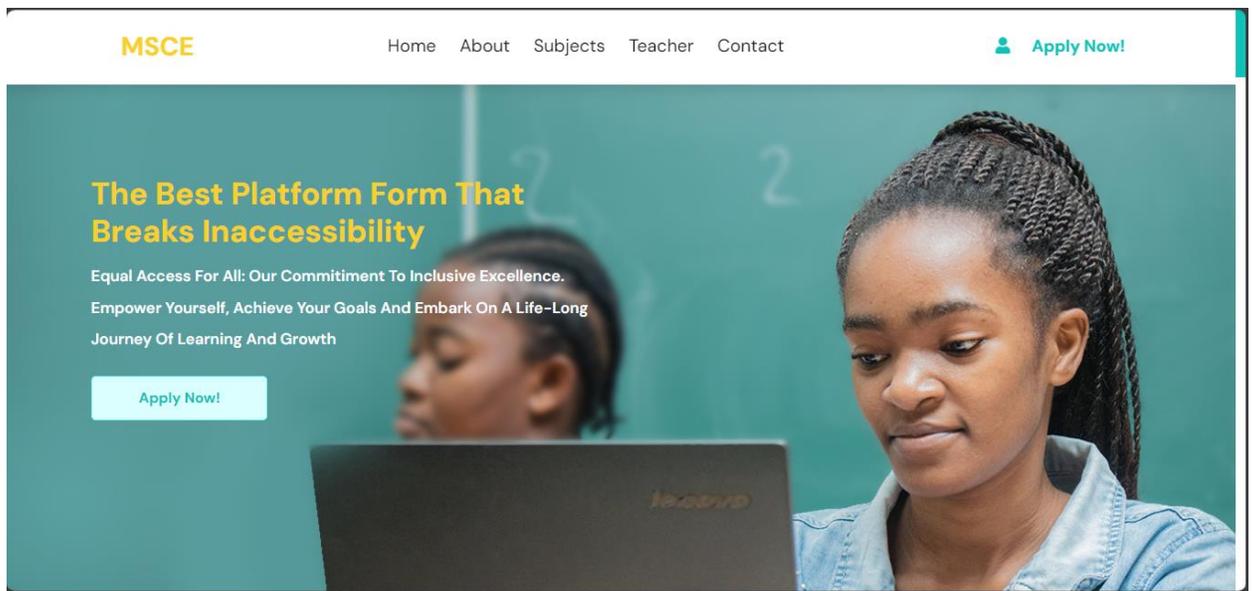
Introduction

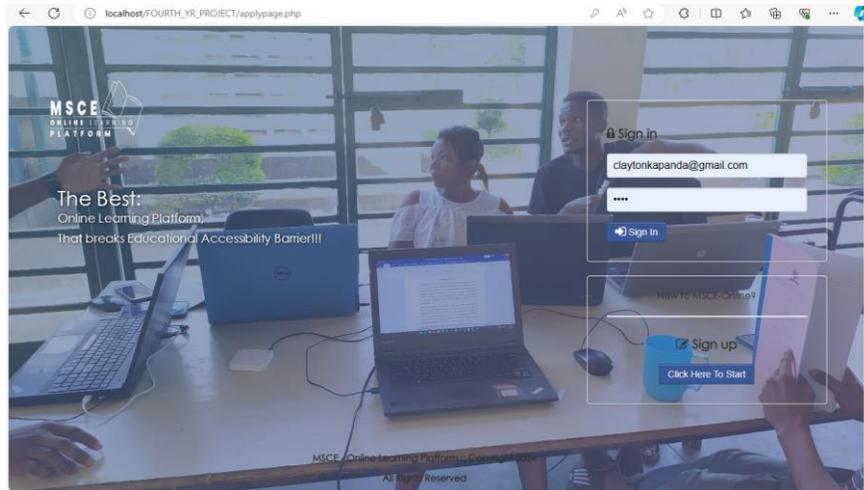

How you Get Started

a. Registration and Login

- click on “apply now” then Sign up to register”.

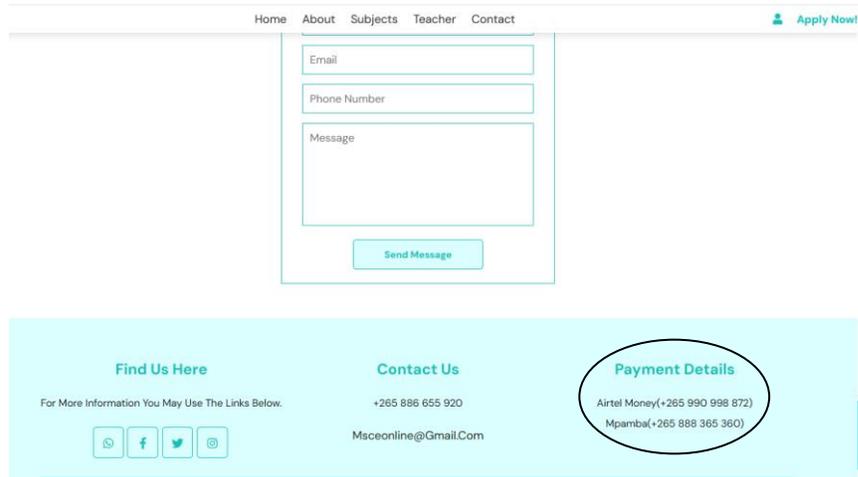




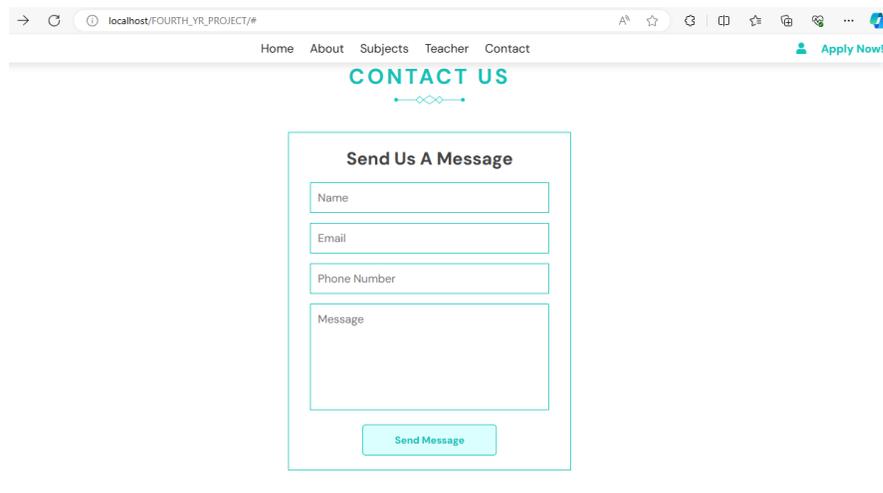

- Fill out the registration form with your details.

- Verify your Username (email address) and set up a strong password.
- Transfer registrations fees through Pamba or airtel money and send transactions details to admin so that you can be added in their system.



- Once transactions have been successful, the admin will give you confirmation message that you can **log in** into the platform using your **credentials**.



b. Platform Navigation

- The dashboard displays your enrolled class, year of enrolment, notifications, profile details and messages.
- Use the left navigation menu to access your enrolled class, messages, and notifications.

c. Subjects management

i. Finding and Enrolling in Subjects

- Browse **My class** by clicking to access subjects he or she is taking.
- Click on a subject to view details such as classmates, progress, subjects overview, downloadable materials, assignments. Announcements, class calendar and quiz.

ii. Subjects Structure and Contents

- Subjects are divided into humanities, sciences and languages.
- Lessons may include video lectures, quizzes, assignments and sometimes live classes.
- Use My class to access subject and then click on subject to access lessons and resources on that particular time based on the schedules assigned by the teacher.
